Re: Acceptance criteria for drum receiving effective June 1, 2007

Attn:

As you are aware, effective January 1, 2007 Alberta Drum Inc. amalgamated with Civic Recycling & Equipment 1995 Ltd. In order to be permitted to operate under our new name, the City of Calgary and Alberta Environmental Protection, have stipulated that, Civic Recycling & Equipment 1995 Ltd, is not to store any drums with free-flowing exterior product residue. Free-flowing residual will be defined as any product which may run off the surface of the drum, under any given weather conditions, of its own volition.

In addition to this added criteria Civic will refuse any drums that do not have both bungs, rings and lids securely in place or drums that contain 1 inch or more residual waste within the drums. Drums in which the internal residual content is in question will be measured. There will be no exceptions to these guidelines regardless of previous contents. Therefore Civic is requesting that all customers make necessary adjustments to ensure that drums meeting this description are not arriving at our facility.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, however, it is necessary in order to comply with regulatory guidelines set forth to our company. Any drums that do arrive at our facility that are deemed to be non-compliant with these guidelines will be refused and returned to the point of origin at the customers' expense.
